2nd Annual *Golfing for Good* Tournament to Benefit The Arc of Atlantic County September 25

Proceeds from the tournament will support The Arc of Atlantic County's recreation program that helps more than 300 people with developmental disabilities build confidence, make friends and learn new skills through a variety of athletic and social activities. Last year, the event netted more than \$23,000.

Registration will begin at 7:30 a.m. with a 9:00 a.m. shotgun start in a scramble format. The cost is \$125 per golfer or \$500 for a foursome. Tickets for the luncheon only are \$30. Contests during the tournament include the following: top three foursomes; longest drive (men's or women's); closest to the pin on all par 3s; beat the pro; and hole-in-one. Prizes will be awarded during the luncheon following the tournament at the Harbor Pines Club House.
